Academic Accommodations

What is a reasonable academic accommodation?

A reasonable academic accommodation is any modification or adjustment that will enable a qualified student with a disability to participate in a course, program, activity, or service. Reasonable academic accommodations assure that students with a disability have rights, privileges, and access equal to students without disabilities.

Reasonable academic accommodations may include academic adjustments, auxiliary aids or adaptive technology, outreach services, or physical access modifications.

How to arrange academic accommodations?

If you have a disability requiring academic accommodations, below are the steps to gaining the assistance you need to succeed:

- Visit the Disability Services website (https://studentsuccess.indianatech.edu/disabilities) and complete the Request for Academic Accommodations Packet. The packet is linked on the disability services website. You can fill the packet out digitally or print and fill it out by hand.
- Submit your completed Academic Accommodations Packet along with documentation from a qualified professional outlining the specific nature of your disability to the Disability Services Coordinator, Angela Williams, via email, mail, or fax.
- Schedule an intake meeting with Angela Williams, the Disability Services Coordinator. You can schedule an appointment with Angela by emailing her or connecting by phone call.
